Dear Lord Gill,

In answer to a letter published in the Daily Mail, concerning & During my time in appealing to the Court of Sessions, solicitors acting behalf of the insurance company who had also been my insurers, had influenced the Clerk of the Court of Sessions to remove the most crucial part of my Evidence out of my process, 4 Months prior to my case being heard by the 3 appeal Judges, which included the Record of my case.

Solicitors also misled the Court by putting my case under the wrong court procedure.

My case, being a Rd traffic Accident, where I was Bodily injured, with Spinal injuries, also damage to my Right foot, leaving me with a permanent limp, I have never had Redress. Which of Course is due.

Solicitors have been responsible for the injustice I have suffered for the past 10 years, & although, I had tried to open my case in the Court of Sessions, have been prevented from doing so, by clerks of the Court, giving me wrong information, I have letters to prove that statement.

I had lost my livelihood, which at the time of the Rd traffic Accident, I had been training to be an Adi (Advanced Driving instructor) & could had taken on any skilled Driving work apart from becoming a Driving instructor such as Chauffeur or running a Taxi Business.

My car involved in the Rd traffic Accident became a Write off. but, the information concerning my Rd traffic Accident had been retained from the Court, through no fault of my own.


