


I, James Alastair Taylor, Sheriff Principal of Glasgow and Strathkelvin, for the purposes of regulating practice in the Sheriff Court at Glasgow in pursuance of the powers conferred under Section 15(2) of the Sheriff Courts (Scotland) Act 1971 and all common law powers enabling in that behalf Order and Direct as follows:-

1. With effect from 7 September 2009 there will be no diet roll for civil business in the Glasgow Sheriff Court. There will continue to be a roll for Rule 18.3 hearings and for peremptory diet cases. If a diet is not fixed in the course of the hearing when the diet is allowed, agents should write to the Sheriff Clerk intimating suitable dates for the diet within a 3 month period. The Sheriff Clerk will take all reasonable steps to assign the diet to one of the days nominated.
