- [1] The Appellant has failed to comply with an Order of the Tribunal to;
 - Lodge her Notice of Appeal by completing and submitting the Upper Tribunal Form UTS-1.
 - Comply with the terms of Rule 3 of The Upper Tribunal for Scotland (Rules of Procedure) Regulations 2016. In particular,
 - (i) in her Notice of Appeal;
 - (a) identify the decision of the First-tier Tribunal to which it relates; and
 - (b) identify the alleged error or errors of law in the decision.

- (ii) lodge with the Notice of Appeal,
 - (a) any written record of the decision being challenged;
 - (b) any separate written statement of reasons for that decision; and
 - (c) the notice of permission to appeal from the First-tier Tribunal.
- (iii) specify the date of receipt by her of the notice of permission to appeal from the First-tier Tribunal.

[2] The Tribunal gave notice to the Appellant that it proposed to dismiss the Appellant's case in terms of Rule 10 of The Upper Tribunal for Scotland (Rules of Procedure) Regulations 2016, and invited the Appellant, should she wish to make representations in relation to the proposed dismissal to do so in writing to reach the Tribunal by 5pm on 29 March 2019.

[3] The Appellant has failed to make representations by the due date.

[4] In terms of Rule 10 of The Upper Tribunal for Scotland (Rules of Procedure)

Regulations 2016, the Tribunal dismisses the purported appeal and the proceedings.
