Notice of an Inquiry under the Inquiries into Fatal Accidents and Sudden Deaths etc (Scotland) Act 2016.

MOIRA ORR, PROCURATOR FISCAL FOR THE DISTRICT OF GLASGOW AND STRATHKELVIN AT GLASGOW GIVES NOTICE UNDER SECTION 15(1) OF THE INQUIRIES INTO FATAL ACCIDENTS AND SUDDEN DEATHS ETC. (SCOTLAND) ACT 2016 THAT:

1. An inquiry into the death of Freya Murphy is to be held.
2. The inquiry is a discretionary inquiry under Section 4(1) (a)(ii) and 4(1b) of the Inquiries into the Fatal Accidents and Sudden Deaths etc. (Scotland) Act 2016. The Lord Advocate having considered that the death of Freya Murphy (hereafter referred to as the deceased) occurred in circumstances giving rise to serious public concern and that it is in the public interest for a public inquiry to be held into the circumstances of the death.
3. A Preliminary Hearing has been fixed for 9:30am, 22 September 2022 at Glasgow Sheriff Court.
4. An Inquiry has been fixed for 10am, 30 January 2023 at Glasgow Sheriff Court.
