- 1. An inquiry into the death of Robyn Goldie is to be held.
- 2. The inquiry is a discretionary inquiry under section 4(1)(a)(ii) and 4(1)(b) of the Inquiries into Fatal Accidents and Sudden Deaths etc. (Scotland) Act 2016, the Lord Advocate having considered that the death of Robyn Goldie occurred in circumstances giving rise to serious public concern and that it is in the public interest for a public inquiry to be held into the circumstances of the death
- 3. The Procurator Fiscal considers that a Preliminary Hearing is necessary to allow the parties to settle the scope of the FAI; identify matters likely to arise during the FAI; identify matters likely to be in dispute; and establish a framework for the course of the FAI.
- 4. A Preliminary Hearing has been fixed for 9:30am, 3<sup>rd</sup> July 2023 within the Sheriff Court House at Hamilton, Sheriff court House, 4 Beckford Street, ML3 0BT.
