

SHERIFFDOM OF GRAMPIAN, HIGHLAND AND ISLANDS AT INVERNESS

ANDREW SHANKS, PROCURATOR FISCAL FOR THE DISTRICT OF INVERNESS GIVES NOTICE UNDER SECTION 17(3) OF THE INQUIRIES INTO FATAL ACCIDENTS AND SUDDEN DEATHS ETC. (SCOTLAND) ACT 2016 THAT:

1. An inquiry into the death of David James Taylor is to be held.
2. The inquiry is a mandatory inquiry under the Inquiries into Fatal Accidents and Sudden Deaths etc. (Scotland) Act 2016 section 2 as David Taylor's death was the result of an accident that occurred on the Muckrach Estate, Dulnain Bridge, Morayshire in the Sheriff Court District of Inverness whilst he was acting in the course of his employment.
3. The date fixed for the start of the inquiry is Thursday 9th February 2023 at 10.00 a.m. and a preliminary hearing has been fixed for Wednesday 11th January 2023 at 9.30 a.m.

Both the preliminary hearing and inquiry are to take place within the Court House at the Justice Centre, Longman Road, Inverness by WebEx video conference and parties wishing to participate are required to provide their email address, telephone number and a brief outline of their position to inverness@scotcourts.gov.uk no later than close of business on Wednesday 4th January 2023.
