GIVES NOTICE UNDER SECTION 17(3) OF THE INQUIRIES INTO FATAL ACCIDENTS
AND SUDDEN DEATHS ETC. (SCOTLAND) ACT 2016 THAT:

1. An inquiry into the death of Ann Margaret Drummond is to be held, with a Preliminary Hearing to be held at 0930 hours on 8 November 2022, at Sheriff Court House at Livingston, Sheriff Court, Civic Centre, Livingston, EH54 6FF and will take place virtually by means of WebEx.
2. The Inquiry is a discretionary Inquiry under section 4 of the Inquiries into Fatal Accidents and Sudden Deaths etc. (Scotland) Act 2016, as the said Ann Margaret Drummond died as a result of being assaulted by Kevin Marks or McFaulds. This Inquiry is necessary to examine the mental health care and treatment provided to the said Mr. Marks or McFaulds prior to the incident.
