#### Refixing of summary non-custodial cited and remand court diets in terms of Section 137ZB(1) of the Criminal Procedure (Scotland) Act 1995

This notice concerns the following categories of cases due to call in all Sheriff and Justice of the Peace Courts in the Sheriffdom of Tayside, Central and Fife: -

1. All cases due to call, including those awaiting a first calling, in the **cited courts** excepting those cases (a) where the accused is in custody in respect of that case or (b) where a letter pleading not guilty has been received by the prosecutor at least 48 hours in advance of the diet and the procedure under Part 4(C) in "Order in respect of Summary and Solemn Criminal Business No 9 of 2020" dated 30 June 2020 has been followed);
2. All cases due to call in the **remand** courts excepting those cases (a) where the accused is in custody in respect of that case or (b) which are scheduled to call for that accused on the same date and in the same court as a case under (a).

Existing diets are no longer suitable for the courts for all such cases due to call in the period between 01 August 2020 March and 31 August 2020, both dates inclusive. These diets will be altered by the court in terms of section 137ZB of the Criminal Procedure (Scotland) Act 1995.

The diets for such cases will be discharged and re-fixed as follows:

- For cases due to call in week commencing 03 August 2020 and week commencing 10 August 2020, a new diet will be fixed for the week commencing 21 December 2020 or any other week deemed suitable;
- For cases due to call in week commencing 17 August 2020 and 24 August 2020, a new diet will be fixed for the week commencing 28 December 2020 or any other week deemed suitable;

This Order is subject to any order made by the court in any case fixing a different diet in that case.
