The Sheriff, having heard the evidence, and examined the documents, and having considered the submissions, DETERMINES in terms of Section 6(1)(a) of the Act, that Stewart McBlain, born 23 January 1940, ordinarily resident at 136C Walker Avenue, Troon, Ayrshire, at the time of his death a prisoner in legal custody at H M Prison, Bowhouse, Kilmarnock died within cell H10, Block 2, H M Prison, Bowhouse, Kilmarnock on 12 December 2007 at or about 21.10 hours and in terms of Section 6(1)(b) of the Act that the cause of death was hanging.
