SHERIFF'S DETERMINATION

At 1135 the Sheriff Finds that Adrian John Fleurs, born 18th January 1966, then a Prisoner being held in legal custody and serving a sentence of imprisonment at HM Prison Peterhead died there in his cell at 15.57 on 20th March 2006 and that the cause of his death was Coronary Artery Disease
