SCOTTISH PARLIAMENTARY QUESTION S4W-13821 MONEY CONFISCATED IN THE ILLEGAL SALE OF TOBACCO

The Cabinet Secretary in his response to the above PQ indicated that it relates to operational matters within the responsibility of the Scottish Court Service corporate body. I am now writing to you in response to the matter you have raised.

S4W-13821 asks: how much money has been confiscated by the courts in each of the last five years following convictions for (i) the illegal sale of and (ii) selling illicit tobacco. (13821)

The Scottish Court Service database showed 67 convictions relating to the illegal sale of tobacco and selling illicit tobacco from 1 January 2008 to 31 December 2012. None of these convictions resulted in a confiscation or forfeiture order being applied by the courts.
