in Inquiry into the circumstances of the death of **WALLACE BRADFORD KIDD**

in terms of Section 6 of the Fatal Accidents and Sudden Deaths Inquiry (Scotland) Act 1976

PAISLEY, 26th November 2004

The Sheriff DETERMINES as follows:-

- In terms of Section 6(1)(a) of the Act that Wallace Bradford Kidd, who was born on 1 June 1950 and late of 304 Keal Drive, Glasgow died on 1 August 2003 at 1220 hours at the Victoria Infirmary Glasgow, having sustained injury in an accident, while in the course of his employment, in which he was struck from behind by a Renault Espace motor vehicle registration number HV03 WNN which pushed him into the rear of his vehicle registration number AKZ 8275.
- In terms of Section 6(1)(b) of the Act that the cause of his death was Back and abdominal injuries sustained in the accident.
- In terms of Section 6(1)(c) of the Act there were no reasonable precautions whereby the death and any accident resulting in the death might have been avoided.
- In terms of Section 6(1)(d) of the Act there were no defects in any system of working which contributed to the death or any accident resulting in the death.
- In terms of Section 6(1)(e) of the Act there are no other facts relevant to the circumstances of the death.
