NOTE

Robert William Anderson who was born on 28 October 1947 whilst driving on the A947 Oldmeldrum to Newmachar Road on 29 March 2006 at approximately 05:55 hours was involved in a road traffic collision with another vehicle. It took well over an hour for the emergency services to free Mr Anderson from his vehicle. When he was freed and taken to hospital it was ascertained that he had suffered multiple injuries and lost a considerable amount of blood. He died from these injuries on 29 March 2006 at 10.42 a.m. at Aberdeen Royal Infirmary, Foresterhill, Aberdeen. The probable cause of the accident was the loss of control of his vehicle by the driver of the other vehicle involved, which loss of control can be attributed to the presence of ice on the road at the place of the accident. The road generally was not icy. There

was no evidence that the driving of the deceased, in any way, contributed to the accident.
