

SHERIFFDOM OF LOTHIAN AND BORDERS DESIGNATION OF SPECIALIST SHERIFFS – PERSONAL INJURY COURTS REFORM (SCOTLAND) ACT 2014

The Lord President has made a direction dated 30 July 2015 under section 34 of the Courts Reform (Scotland) Act 2014 determining that actions of damages for, or arising from, personal injuries or the death of a person from personal injuries are a category of case that the Lord President considers to be suited to being dealt with by sheriffs and summary sheriffs that specialise in that category case.

I, Sheriff Principal Nigel Ross, Sheriff Principal of Lothian and Borders, under the powers conferred on my by section 35(2) of the Courts Reform (Scotland) Act 2014, designate the following sheriff of the Sheriffdom of Lothian and Borders as specialist in actions of damages for, or arising from, personal injuries or the death of a person from personal injuries with effect from 1 August 2025 –
